Rules for Dancing:

- 1. All dancing events are conducted under the rules of the S.O.B.H.D.
- 2. Final breakdown of classes for competition will be determined by the dance committee when all entries have been received.
- 3. Any dancer not ready when called shall forfeit entry in that event.
- 4. The dancing committee reserves the right to place as many dancers on the platform as it deems advisable.
- 5. B.H.G.A. reserves the right to change program to fit # of dancers and time frame.
- 6. First to enter is last to dance.
- 7. Competitor's age is based on age on day of the games.
- 8. Dancers must dance to pipers provided
- 9. Dancer's must fill in for Reels as necessary. Fill in must dance the whole dance.
- 10. Good sportsmanship is required of all competitors, parents, families and instructors.
- 11. Competitors or family members **must not** approach the Judges, Scruitneers or Dance Pipers during competition.. Failure to comply can result in disqualification for awards.
- 12. Judges decisions are final. Any protest must be made in writing and handed to the Games Secretary **accompanied by a \$25.00 fee before distribution of prizes**. If the dance committee sustains the protest, fee will be returned.

Dancing Prizes - All dancers must show F.U.S.T.A. or Scot Dance Canada card to receive winnings.

Washington Only competition is a Trophy dance (no monetary award given).

Primary, Beginners, Novice, Intermediate, and Premier 15 & under - a medal will be awarded.

Premier 16 & over will receive a monetary award for winning in class events.

Aggregate awards will be keeper trophies and be awarded Saturday and Sunday.

Perpetual awards are based on total of Saturday AND Sunday scores combined and be awarded on Sunday.
